

Elevation Tier - A status that represents an Elevation Robot's height off of the field at the end of the match.

Note: There are no addition Elevation Tier above the Height Guide. Robot which end the match above the Height Guide will be considered to be at the maximum, Elevation Tier J.

Note 2: Robots that are no Elevation do not receive an Elevation Tier.

<SC6> Elevation points are comparative, and are awarded based on the Elevation Tiers achieved by all Robots at the end of the match. The highest-Elevation Robot will receive the highest number of Elevation points, followed by the second-highest, and so on. If multiple Robots are measured at the same Elevation Tier, they will receive the same amount of point.
