

- b. Entering an opponent's Goal at any other time is prohibited. This includes staying inside of an opponent's Goal after they end their Double-Zoning status.
- c. If an Alliance has only one Robot present, then that Alliance can never meet the definition of Double-Zoning.

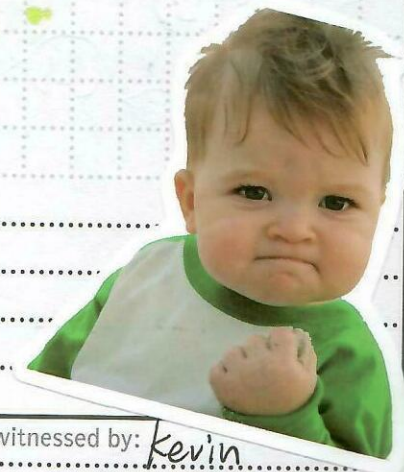
We notice that there are no rules that prohibit an Alliance from forcing an opponent into a Double-Zoned status, assuming no other rules are violated in the process.

<SG10> Enter the Neutral Zone during Autonomous at your own risk.

In the context of <G14>, the Zone will always determine "offensive" / "defensive". If an interaction occurred in the Neutral Zone that required a Head Referee judgment call, then the Robot of the same color as the Offensive Zone will receive the "benefit of the doubt".

<R12> Motors are limited. Robots may use any combination of VEX V5 Smart Motors (11W) (276-4840) and V5 Smart Motors (5.5W) (276-4842).

The combined power of all motors must not exceed 88W.
